TERMS AND CONDITIONS :

1. HOW TO ENTER: No payment necessary. To enter the Wish Upon A Star Competition you must be between 5 and 13 years of age (inclusive) as of 25 September 2009. Entries in both age categories must include a completed star and official entry form. Artwork must be no larger than 42cm x 29.7cm (A3) and created on paper, card or poster board only. Entries can be delivered to any branch of The National Bank during the month of September, up until Friday 25 September 2009. Entries can also be sent to Wish Upon a Star Competition, c/- Bethany Campbell, The National Bank, PO Box 7191, Wellington. Entries must be received no later than Friday 25 September 2009. You may enter as often as you wish, but all artwork on each entry must be original and created solely by the entrant.

2. JUDGING: The judging of the entries will be divided into two categories; 9 to 13 years old; and 5 to 8 years old. Within each category there will be one national winner and 11 regional winners. The exact definition of regions and allocations of entries within those regions will be at Life Education Trust's sole discretion. Entries will be judged regionally by regional panels of judges. Regional winner's entries will automatically enter the national competition for the grand prizes for each category. Entries will be judged on the artworks originality, imagination and artistic merit. The writing on stars does not form part of the judging process, but information is used to give further insight into judging the artwork. The judge's decision is final and no correspondence will be entered into.

3. PRIZES: 9 to 13 year old category prizes: The national winner of this age category wins a live video conference call for his/her class to talk with a NASA Astronaut, Nicole Stott, at the International Space Station, 200 miles above Earth. He/she also wins \$1000 for their school, their wish sent to space and broadcast by an astronaut plus Harold the Giraffe merchandise. 11 regional winners will get their wish sent to space and broadcast from space and Harold merchandise. 5 to 8 year old category prizes: The national winner of this age category wins a 1GB iPod shuffle, \$1000 for their school, \$500 art supplies for their school, their wish sent to space and broadcast by an astronaut plus Harold the Giraffe merchandise. 11 regional winners will also get their wish broadcast from space and Harold merchandise.

4. WINNER NOTIFICATION: Winners will be notified by phone or post within 14 days of the competition closing. The names of the winners will be published in Harold's Space Diary www.haroldinspace.co.nz.

5. Life Education Trust will not accept or take responsibility for any entries that are incomplete, illegible or damaged. Nor will it accept entries with insufficient postage.

6. If, for reasons beyond our control the space travel or live link to space does not eventuate, Life Education Trust will not be held accountable or have any liability. Another suitable prize will be offered to the winning children and classes.
